colotomy as indicated. Intraoperative EGD and colonoscopy can aid in ensuring complete GI clearance. Monitoring for postoperative infections is warranted, as there may be up to a 32.9–40% risk of wound infections.¹²

The patient underwent an exploratory laparotomy with removal of over 60 drug packets. Despite a prolonged hospitalization, he made a full recovery.
