- Maintain a current, active, unrestricted medical licenses and certifications necessary to practice as a physician;
- Possess a Basic Military Aerospace Medicine Certification or be Board Certified in Aerospace Medicine, Family Practice, Internal Medicine or Emergency Medicine;
- Possess and Maintain current CPR by either the American Heart Association or the Red Cross;
- Possess and Maintain current ACLS certification;
- Possess and Maintain current Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) registration.
